Patriot Marker Grants - The Storage Administration just announced that Patriot Marker Grants will soon be available. States may receive \$1,000 and chapters may receive \$500 to dedicate a Patriot marker, or placing or rededicating Revolutionary War plaques, monuments, and gravesites. More information on these grants will be available in the next several weeks as the program gets up and running.

Community Engagement – Initiatives include chapters collaborating with units of local government to create Proclamations that brings attention to our nation's milestone and connects communities to your local DAR Chapter. Photos of chapter activities should be action oriented and multi-generational in nature. Published on social media and other outlets, these photos will demonstrate to the public that the society is for everyone from Daughters in their late teens to the well-seasoned Daughter. These photos will be a wonderful way to share the opportunity with prospective members of all ages.

Club 250! – All Chapters are encouraged to become a member of "Club 250", an exclusive club available to ALL Illinois DAR Chapters. Chapters who publicize an *America 250!* activity in at least 1 or more categories of Chapter, Community, Veterans, and Youth, will be recognized at State Conference.
