## 2025-2026 State Project: Hope for Veterans: A Path Forward

Supporting Veterans Path to Hope (Crystal Lake, IL), a nonprofit dedicated to helping veterans overcome homelessness, unemployment and food insecurity.

Since 1996, Veterans Path to Hope has provided housing, resources, and support to veterans from WWII through today.

**This year's fundraising supports two key programs:**

- **Veterans' Grants** – assistance with urgent needs such as car repairs, shelter, clothing, and household essentials. Reliable transportation is vital for maintaining jobs, accessing medical care, and meeting daily needs.
- **Veterans' Service Dinners** – monthly meals for 25–30 veterans at a cost of \$300 each group, providing food, fellowship, and community support that strengthens mental health and bonds.

**Goal: Raise \$10,000 to fund one year of service dinners and provide essential grants for veterans in need.**
