<u>IMPORTANT</u>

Chapter Achievement Credit!

For Chapter Achievement, your chapter MUST contribute at least \$40 toward a magazine ad, either individually or through a cooperative District ad. This money goes to your District Treasurer.

The \$40 paid in 2025 for the co-op ad is for 2026 Chapter Achievement year. This year's (2025) magazine contributions are for next year's (2026) Chapter Achievement.

To qualify for additional Chapter Achievement points, your chapter must have one of the following: For 30 points - subscriptions totaling at least 31% of the chapter membership, as of 1/1/2026.

For 20 points - subscriptions totaling more than 20% but less than 31% of the chapter membership

Remember EACH subscription counts toward the total - including those donated to schools and libraries. NOTE: All renewals and subscriptions payments must be received by the NSDAR Magazine Office before December 31, 2025.
